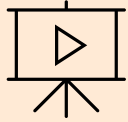

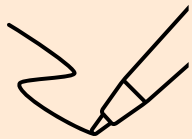

If we don't have a friend like that, we can be that friend for someone else




